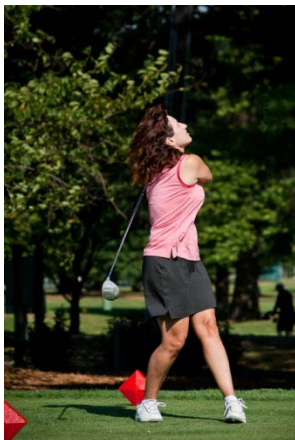




The Sigma Chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma 10th Annual Sigma Chapter Golf Outing Tuesday, September 7th, 2010
