Attendees from 65 chapters across the country enjoyed a comprehensive agenda that included a career fair, educational and leadership sessions, and keynote address.

The Sigma Chapter received Chapter Awards for its achievements in Alumni Relations, Chapter Management, Community Service, Membership Development, and Public Relations. In addition, the Sigma Chapter, along with four other chapters, was recognized as a Superior Chapter. 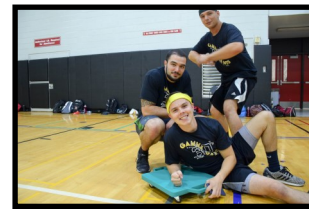
