## Sigma Chapter Attends the 45th Annual Gamma Iota Sigma Management Conference

From Thursday, September 29 to Sunday, October 2, 2016, Sigma Chapter officers and advisors traveled to Columbus, Ohio to attend the 45<sup>th</sup> Annual Gamma Iota Sigma International Management Conference. This event hosted members from 65 chapters across the country and provided them with an extensive agenda which included a career fair, educational and leadership sessions, and keynote addresses.

At the Annual Awards dinner on Friday evening, the Sigma Chapter earned Chapter Awards for its achievements in Alumni Relations, Chapter Management, Community Service, Membership Development, and Public Relations. In addition, the Sigma Chapter, among only four other chapters, was recognized as a Superior Chapter for exceling in all functional areas and providing exceptional experiences for its members. The Sigma Chapter also won four Black and Gold Awards, which recognize new projects and programs considered creative and successful only through extensive planning and organization participation. These awards were given for Intern Testimonials, Fox's Got Talent, Excel Training Workshop Series, and Alumni Student Mentoring Program.

Individual Awards were also presented during the ceremony and two of the three given were to Sigma Chapter members. Carolyn Murset, Class of 2016 and previous Executive Vice President of the Sigma Chapter, received the Warren L. Weeks Award. Given in tribute to Warren L. Weeks, an outstanding teacher and insurance industry leader, this award is meant to encourage member leadership and the furthering of fraternity goals.
