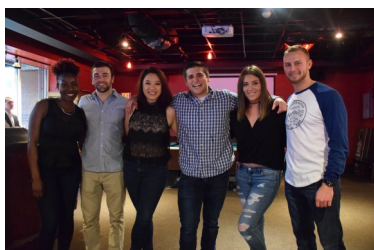
Annual Charity Auction
