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Sigma Chapter announces winner of American Association of Managing General Agents Student White Paper Research Contest

The American Association of Managing General Agents was founded in 1926 and serves as a trade association to international wholesale insurance professionals. The AAMGA has also acted as a representative for its members before the federal, state, and local governments and regulatory agencies and other administrators and trade associations in the United States, Canada and Europe.

The AAMGA's annual White Paper Research Contest is open to those students enrolled in Risk Management and Insurance Programs nationwide. Students are prompted to research and write about a current topic of interest in the insurance industry. The papers are broken into three categories: Industry Concerns and the Impact on the Wholesaler, Emerging Risks and How Wholesalers can Best Address Them, and Technology and the Wholesaler. A winner is then picked from each category and receives a \$1,000 scholarship, an all expense paid trip to the AAMGA's 90th Annual Meeting in Scottsdale, AZ, the opportunity to shadow an AAMGA member during their meetings at the conference, and publication of their writing in the May issue of *Wholesale Insurance News* magazine, which is seen by over 1.4 million insurance professionals in 40 countries around the world.
