Beginning on October 31, 2016, College Council in the Fox School of Business began their annual food drive. College Council is a group within the Fox School designed to oversee all Student Professional Organizations (SPO's). The Council also serves as a liaison between the organizations and the university. They hold monthly meetings with representatives from each SPO to discuss updates and issues within the SPO community.

This year, the Council decided to team up with a local charity, Philabundance, to help fight hunger during the holiday season. The Council set a goal to raise 2,200 pounds of food in order to provide over 1,400 meals to families within the Philadelphia area.
