## Sigma Chapter Raises \$14,000 for Gift of Life Family House

Each year, the Sigma Chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma selects a Charity of Choice. In the Fall of 2018, the Sigma Chapter chose Gift of Life Family House as its 2018-2019 Charity of Choice. Beginning in September 2018 and continuing until April 2019, the Chapter hosted bake sales, merchandise sales, a FOX -hole tournament, and a charity auction and collected donations in order to raise almost \$14,000... and counting!

At a very special final body meeting on Wednesday, April 24, 2018, we presented our check to Howard Nathan, the President & CEO of Gift of Life Donor Program and the Founder of the Gift of Life Family House. Mary Smith, the mothers of one of the two individuals from our program, was also present. We honored the legacy of Eric Smith (Class of 2011) and Kevin Kless (Class of 2010), who both donated their organs after passing away suddenly. Gift of Life Family House provides affordable lodging, meals, and services for transplant patients and their families who have traveled to the Philadelphia region to receive medical care. The Sigma Chapter supports the Adopt-a-Family Program, which seeks to cover the \$40 cost per night charged to families, ensuring that no family is turned away due to an inability to pay.
