

Fall 2019 Capstone Case Competition

Monday, November 18, 2019

On Saturday, November 2, 2019, RMI undergraduate students taking the *Managing Risk Across the Enterprise* capstone course participated in a case competition under the instruction of Professor Jim Harrington. The students, paired in teams of three, prepared a risk assessment of a publicly traded firm. The students were required to understand the firm's industry, identify material risks, and assess the potential impact of these significant inherent risks, including reputational injury. The project also required an analysis of event-driven Board liability arising from these material risks. The risk assessment was based upon Enterprise Risk Management principles, and in this spirit, the students also had to prepare a risk register and risk map. Risk Management and Insurance professionals served as judges for the competition and rated the students based on their written reports and oral presentations.
