On Wednesday, March 29, 2017, Sigma Chapter members traveled to Washington D.C. to attend the chartering of the Gamma Alpha Chapter at Gallaudet University. The Gamma Alpha Chapter initiated 28 students and became the 73rd chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma.
