Sigma Chapter Wins at Indy



For the 8th consecutive year Sigma Chapter has won the prestigious Edison L. Bowers Award. The award was presented at the 35th annual Gamma Iota Sigma Management conference in Indianapolis, Indiana. The Bowers Award is given annually to the best Gamma Iota Sigma Chapter in the country. In addition to winning the Bowers award, Sigma Chapter also received six Black and Gold awards, which recognize the innovation in chapter management. Black and Gold awards included How to Run a Beef and Beverage Event, Alumni Luncheon, Internship Board, How to Run a Lady Luck Lottery Fundraiser, Sigma Chapter 25th Anniversary, and How to Run a Corporate Trek.
