Fraudulent and Frazzled

A woman who reported a pair of expensive ski trousers stolen forgot to take them off before going to the police station. She had hoped to claim back the insurance. The 23-year-old from Holland was on holiday in Austria when she tried to make her claim.

She told police in Erpfendorf in Tyrol that her skis and skiwear had been stolen. But she confessed to attempted fraud after police officers pointed out that she was wearing them. She told police: "I was so nervous about making the claim that I forgot to take the trousers off. I wanted the insurance money for university.

The case has been handed over to the Erpfendorf public prosecutor who will decide whether to press charges for attempted fraud.
