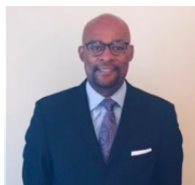

As Senior Vice President, Chief Risk Management & Insurance Officer for the NBA, Anshell Boggs leads the league's Risk Management & Insurance department, overseeing all related programs including crisis management and the procurement and management of domestic and international insurance programs for the league and its affiliates.

Since joining the NBA in 2007, Boggs has managed the league's insurance captives, expanded leaguewide risk and insurance programs and strengthened its global insurance strategy by partnering with internal and external stakeholders to proactively identify and minimize risk factors. He has also developed the league's crisis management program and co-leads related efforts globally. In addition, Boggs leads the league's Risk Management Advisory Council.

Boggs has more than 25 years of experience in the insurance and risk management fields. Prior to joining the NBA, he served as Head of Risk Management at Toys "R" Us, Inc. where he led the company's Global Risk Management department. Prior to Toys "R" Us, Boggs spent seven years at Pep Boys Corporation, most recently as Director of Risk Management, where he built and managed a successful Global Risk Management department. He started at Pep Boys as a Corporate Workers' Compensation & Safety Manager.

Boggs began his career at Liberty Mutual Insurance, where he held a variety of leadership and management positions in human resources, management, insurance and risk management throughout his 10-year tenure. Boggs is an active member of several organizations, committees and advisory boards, including the National Black MBA Association, Insurance and Risk Management Roundtable Group and Risk Management Insurance Society, and sits on the Board of Trustees of Big Brothers Big Sisters New York. He earned a bachelor's degree, MBA, and master's degree in Global Sports Management from Georgetown University.
