Ms. Seidenberg has over 20 years of diversified experience in the insurance industry in personal and commercial insurance. Her expertise covers risk management, including enterprise risk management, claims, underwriting, insurance consulting and mortgage loan insurance compliance. Prior to joining Centerline in 2008, Ms. Seidenberg was a Senior Risk Manager with the Fannie Mae Housing and Community Development Group in Washington, D.C., where she was responsible for all multifamily insurance oversight, including establishing guidelines, and monitoring policies and procedures.
