Sigma Chapter Hosts the 10th Annual OWLympiad

On Monday, May 20, 2019, the 10th Annual OWLympiad Mathematics Competition took place in the Howard Gittis Student Center. This event is hosted by Temple University's Department of Risk, Insurance, and Healthcare Management, along with the Sigma Chapter of Gamma lota Sigma. Twenty-one schools from Pennsylvania, Delaware, and New Jersey sent 39 teams totaling 149 high school students. Throughout the day, the teams, comprised of eleventh-graders, competed in three different rounds that tested their mathematical knowledge and problem-solving skills. These rounds consisted of a 50-minute team exam, the game of 24, and an oral quiz.

This event would not have been a success without the work of Dr. Krupa Viswanathan, Christopher Fillips, and Brian Zimmie, who worked hard to plan and coordinate the event.
