Spring 2017 Property and Casualty Case Competition

April 17, 2017

On Saturday, April 8, 2017, RMI undergraduate students, under the instruction of Professor M. Michael Zuckerman in the *Managing Risks Across the Enterprise* (Property & Casualty) capstone course, participated in a case competition. Students paired in teams of two or three prepared a risk assessment of a publicly traded firm. The students were required to understand the firm's industry, prepare a SWOT analysis to be used as a platform for the risk assessment, and also analyze the Board's exposure to loss. The risk assessment was based upon Enterprise Risk Management principles, and in this spirit the students had to also prepare a risk register and risk map. Risk Management and Insurance professionals served as judges for the competition and rated the students based on their written reports and oral presentations.
