Walter (Woody) Hope retired from AmerisourceBergen Corporation (CENCORA as of August 31, 2023; NYSE: COR) in July of 2022 after sixteen years as Vice President of Risk Management. In that role, he oversaw the corporation's global property, casualty and management liability insurance portfolios, the related hazard and claim management processes, and coordinated with various AmerisourceBergen subsidiaries and departments on a wide range of insurance, safety and risk-related matters. Woody was also a member of the ABC's Policy Committee and served in an advisory role on the company's Global Quality Council. With sales of more than \$250 billion, AmerisourceBergen Corporation is one of the largest global pharmaceutical sourcing, distribution and service companies, ranking #10 in the 2019 "Fortune 500."

Before joining AmerisourceBergen, Woody served as Director of Risk Management at IKON Office Solutions, Inc. (predecessor to Ricoh USA), a large office equipment distribution and service company (1996 to 2007), and on the staff of Alcoa Standard Corporation's Risk Management Department (1995 to 1996). Prior to his risk management positions, Woody was employed by Liberty Mutual Group, with various roles in their Business and National Accounts Departments (1980 to 1995). Woody received the CPCU designation (Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter) from the American Institute for Property and Liability Underwriters in 1984 and the CLU designation (Chartered Life Underwriter) from the American College in 1989. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Lebanon Valley College (Annville, PA) in 1976.

Woody previously served on the Board of Trustees of The Insurance Society of Philadelphia, and he was active in the Risk and Insurance Management Society's Delaware Valley Chapter and Philadelphia Area Risk Managers' Association.
