For the **ninth year** in a row, and for the **fourteenth out of the past sixteen years** the Sigma Chapter once again brought home the coveted **Edison L Bowers Award** for the most outstanding chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma worldwide.

"We're bringin' it back!" shouted Korey DeVaughn, the Director of Student Activities for the Sigma Chapter, at the announcement of the winner.

Twenty six Sigma Chapter officers and members, and three faculty advisors attended the awards dinner filled with high hopes and a fever for Bowers Banditry.

"I got a fever, and the only cure is more Bowers!" said Paul Rossi the Treasurer for the Sigma Chapter, in the early minutes of Saturday's ceremony.

The **Edison L. Bowers Award**, the highest award a chapter can receive from

the Grand Chapter, is presented to the chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma that demonstrates an exceptional, well-rounded and organized program each academic school year. The **Bowers Award** takes into account public relations, industry relations, alumni affairs as well as various other chapter activities. This award is of significant importance as it designates the most outstanding chapter of Gamma Iota Sigma, from the eyes of the Grand Chapter itself.

The Edison L. Bowers award was not the only award bestowed upon the Sigma Chapter this evening. The Sigma Chapter also received awards recognizing outstanding chapter development in terms of in Community Service, Membership Development, Public Relations, Alumni Relations and Career Development.

Additionally, the Sigma Chapter received four Black and Gold awards, which recognized the Sigma Chapters' involvement in the "Neighborhood Bikeworks Fundraising Project," "The Gamma Ambassadors Program," "Creating an E-Commerce Website," and "Essentials of a Periodic Newsletter" for your favorite periodical Risky Business.

Aaron Hill (Fox Actuarial Science Class of 2008), past President and Alumnus of the Sigma Chapter, received the Thomas J. Miles Actuarial Award established to recognize the one individual member of Gamma Iota Sigma that best represents the qualities of scholarship, leadership, character, and service exemplified by Dr. Miles.

Finally, the Sigma Chapter was also graced with our own Executive Vice-President **Chelsea Balerno** (Fox Actuarial Science Class of 2009) being elected to serve as the student representative of the Executive Committee for Gamma Iota Sigma in 2008-2009.

It certainly was an auspicious evening for the Sigma Chapter, as this was the most awards won by a single chapter <u>ever</u> in the history of Gamma Iota Sigma.
