

The Gift of Life Family House serves as a "home away from home" for transplant patients and their families by providing temporary, affordable lodging, and supportive services to those who travel to Philadelphia for transplant-related care.

The Sigma Chapter has supported the Gift of Life Family House over the past ten years. In 2012, our organization raised \$25,000 for the Family House in memory of Eric Smith (Class of 2011) and Kevin Kless (Class of 2010), graduates of the Fox School's Risk Management & Insurance program who died within seven months of each other and donated their organs to save the lives of others. The \$25,000 raised by our organization in 2012 went towards a guest room at the facility. In 2019, The Sigma Chapter raised an additional \$13,000 for the Gift of Life Family House.

This year, your donations will help support the Adopt-a-Family Program, which seeks to cover the \$40 cost per night to families staying in the Family House, ensuring that no family is turned away due to an inability to pay. All donations are in memory of the 10th anniversary of donating to the Gift of Life Family House in honor of Eric (Class of 2011) and Kevin (Class of 2010). So far we have raised \$4,765 during the Fall 2021 semester and we need your support to reach our \$10,000 donation goal for the 2021-2022 academic year!
