Established in 1979 to honor the late Robert S. The Spencer Educational Foundation is a leading advocate for risk management education and has provided scholarships, grants, and program funding totaling over \$13 million since its founding.

The Spencer Educational Foundation scholarships are available to outstanding applicants who are focused on a career in risk management, insurance, and related disciplines. Recipients must attend a university, four-year college, or two-year college and have a GPA of 3.0 or above. Students chosen as Spencer scholars are awarded a monetary scholarship between the values of \$5,000 and \$10,000 for the academic year.
