Established in 1979 to honor the late Robert S. The Spencer Educational Foundation is a leading advocate for risk management education and has provided scholarships, grants, and program funding totaling over $\$ 13$ million since its founding.

The Spencer Educational Foundation scholarships are available to outstanding applicants who are focused on a career in risk management, insurance, and related disciplines. Recipients must attend a university, fouryear college, or two-year college and have a GPA of 3.0 or above. Students chosen as Spencer scholars are awarded a monetary scholarship between the values of $\$ 5,000$ and $\$ 10,000$ for the academic year.

Additionally, one of our members, Mallory Sanders was selected as one of the top 5 students among all recipients.
