Spring 2019 Actuarial Science Health & Benefits Case Competition

On Saturday, March 30, 2019, undergraduate Actuarial Science students, under the instruction of Professor Diane Luedtke in the Actuarial Practice: Benefits course participated in a case competition. Students teams of four developed assumptions and priced a long-term care insurance product. Actuaries from LTCG, a long-term care insurance consulting company, supplied the data and pricing model used in the exercise. The students were required to prepare an actuarial memorandum outlining their assumption development and pricing methodology, showing their proposed premium rates.
