### **Spring 2019 Property & Casualty Case Competition**

*Tuesday, April 9, 2019*

On Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019, RMI undergraduate students, under the instruction of Professor Jim Harrington in the Managing Risks Across the Enterprise (Property & Casualty) capstone course, participated in a case competition. Students paired in teams of three prepared a risk assessment of a publicly traded firm. The students were required to understand the firm's industry, identify and assess the significant inherent risks, and also analyze the Board's exposure to underlying risk events. The risk assessment was based upon Enterprise Risk Management principles, and in this spirit, the students had to also prepare a risk register and risk map. Risk Management and Insurance professionals served as judges for the competition and rated the students based on their written reports and oral presentations.
