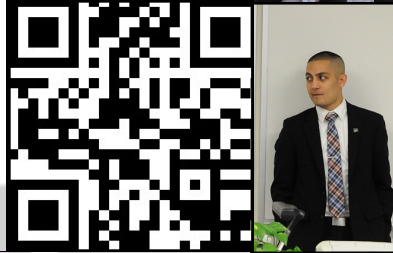
"Networking 101" features industry professionals as they offer students advice on the best ways to approach and make conversation with individuals in the industry.
