William E. "Bill" Cunningham is Executive Vice President of Business Insurance, with oversight responsibility for all of Travelers' Commercial businesses, including National Accounts, Commercial Accounts, Industry Focused, Target Risk, Specialized Distribution and Select Accounts. Prior to his current role, from 2006 to 2010, Mr. Cunningham was Senior Vice President of Business Insurance, with responsibility for the Commercial Middle Market business.

Mr. Cunningham began his career with Travelers as an Account Executive in the Commercial Accounts Marketing Department in Albany, N.Y. He worked as an Account Executive in Albany, Boston, and ultimately Hartford, Conn., also in the Commercial Accounts Marketing Department. Between 1993 and 1997, he held several positions of increasing responsibility in the National Accounts area, becoming Regional Vice President for the Northeast Region of National Accounts.

In 2001, Mr. Cunningham was promoted to President and Chief Executive Officer of Travelers Construction, and in 2005, he became President of National Accounts, with oversight responsibility for Construction, Discover Re and Residual Markets. In 2006, Mr. Cunningham was named to the leadership position in Commercial Accounts.

Mr. Cunningham earned a bachelor's degree from Trinity College in Hartford, Conn., in 1987. In addition, he is founder and President of the Foundation for a Cure for Mitochondrial Disease.


