Ken Phelan joined RBS as Chief Risk Officer for RBS Americas (RBSA) in June, 2011. Reporting both to the RBSA CEO and the RBS Group Head of Risk and Restructuring, Ken is responsible for overseeing Credit, Market, Operational and Compliance risk in the region. He is also an active member of the Group Risk Executive and Management Committees and chairs the Group Risk Operating Committee.

Prior to joining RBS, Ken served as the post conservatorship CRO for Fannie Mae from 2009 - 2011, where he was responsible for Credit, Market and Operational risk across the firm. Prior to Fannie Mae, Ken joined Wachovia in 2008 as CRO where he provided leadership for Credit, Market and Operational risk management while assisting in the transition phase of the company during its merger with Wells Fargo. Prior to Wachovia, Ken held a variety of senior risk roles at JP Morgan, UBS and Credit Suisse in the areas of Risk Strategy Development, Loan Portfolio Management, Risk Policy and Analytics/Methodology and Model Review, Market and Credit Risk Management.

Ken has more than 20 years of experience across risk management, capital markets and structured products. He holds a JD from Villanova University School of Law, an MS in Economics from Trinity College, Dublin and a BS in Finance from Old Dominion University.
