Tom Kunkel is President of Bond & Financial products for Travelers. He has held this position since 2005. In March 2009, Mr. Kunkel was appointed as a member of the company's Management Committee in recognition of his leadership and contributions within Financial, Professional & International Insurance.

Mr. Kunkel joined a predecessor of Travelers in 1984, after working for four years in the industry. After assuming positions of increasing responsibility, he was appointed Manager of the Nebraska/Iowa Bond organization. In 1996, Mr. Kunkel was promoted to Regional Vice President and relocated to Cleveland, Ohio, where he assumed responsibility for all Bond operations in a five state region. In 2001, Mr. Kunkel relocated to the Hartford home office, where he has progressed through various leadership positions, including Chief Underwriting Officer – Northeast/Midwest in the Bond Construction Services business, leader of Bond - Field Management, and leader of Bond - Commercial Surety.

Mr. Kunkel holds a bachelor's degree in Finance from Creighton University in Omaha, Neb., and has been awarded his Associate in Fidelity and Surety Bonding (AFSB). He is the immediate past Chair of the Board of Directors of the Surety Association of America and is a member of the organization's Executive Committee.

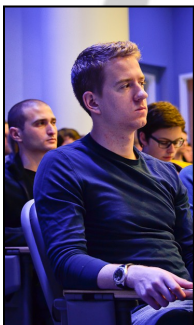
