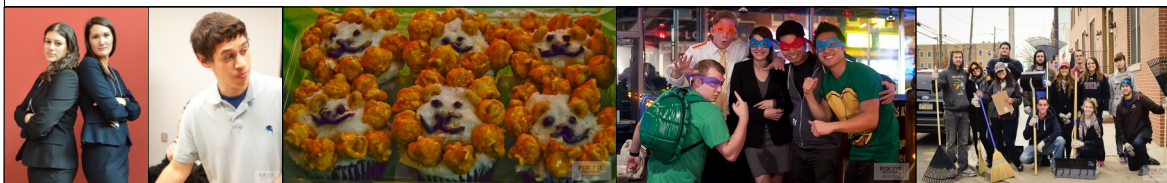

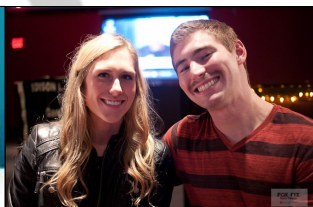
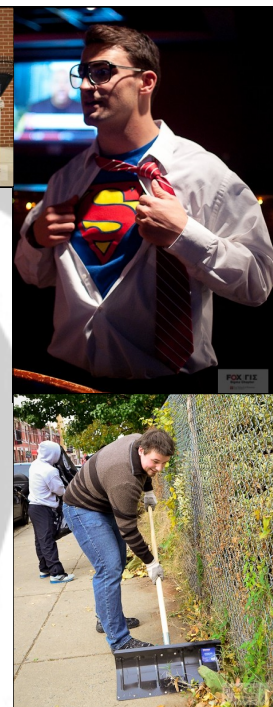


Charity of Choice Update: For Pete's Sake Cancer Respite Foundation
