BA 2101—

As a candidate for a BBA degree, you are required to take BA 2101—Professional Development Strategies. This is a one credit hour course. As a major in RMI or Actuarial Science, you can satisfy this requirement by:

Taking a special section of BA 2101 specifically designed for RMI/AS majors who are also members of GIS.

Students in this option will satisfy their professional development requirement through participating in various activities within GIS. The requirements of BA 2101 through Gamma are as follows:

- **Attend the course orientation workshop on Friday, January 31, 2014 - 12-12:50PM - A031**
- Attend the weekly speaker series each Wednesday from 12:00-12:50PM.
- Join a committee in Gamma and attend the weekly meetings. Meetings are held every other Monday from 12:00-12:50PM.
- Satisfy the requirements to be included in the GIS Resume Book.
- Attend a one-half day Professional Development Workshop given by the Fox School on a Saturday from 9AM-12PM. If you have been CSPD'd through the Fox School and have proof of this, you need not fulfill this particular requirement.
- **Sign up at first organizational meeting.**

RMI 3682—

GIS is able to offer a one-credit hour independent study in Professional Development. This course may be taken by both RMI and Actuarial Science majors and can be taken more than once. This course satisfies a business elective. If you have taken BA 2101 through the Fox School or through GIS, you are eligible to take RMI 3682. The requirements of RMI 3682 are:

- **Attend the course orientation workshop on Friday, January 31, 2014 - 12-12:50PM - A031**
- Attend our weekly H. Wayne Snider Speaker Series each Wednesday from 12:00-12:50PM.
- Attend one of our Community Service Events during the fall semester.
- **Sign up at first organizational meeting.**
