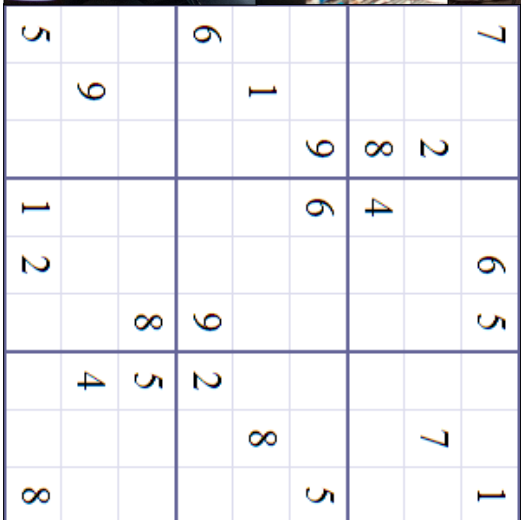
Join Public Relations for an information session where you will have the opportunity to learn what it takes to be an officer in the PR department, while brushing up on skills such as:
