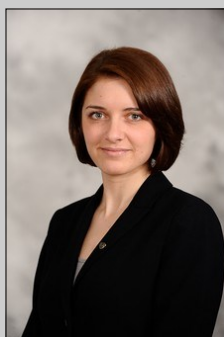

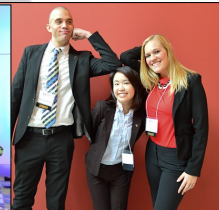
Happy Summer Break!
