Joining AXIS in 2010, Mr. Vogt served until 2012 as the Senior Vice President, Chief Operating Officer & Chief Financial Officer for AXIS Accident & Health, the business segment within AXIS that provides worldwide accident, specialty health and travel-related insurance and reinsurance solutions. In that role, he was responsible for actuarial pricing and reserving, claims management, compliance, finance, information technology, legal, global operations, and U.S. state filing.

Prior to joining AXIS, Mr. Vogt served as Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer at Penn Mutual from 2005 to 2010 where he was responsible for all aspects of accounting and finance, actuarial pricing and reserving, planning, and risk management. Earlier in his career, he held financial and management positions at CIGNA Group Insurance and leadership and actuarial positions at the Hartford Life Insurance Company.

Mr. Vogt received his BBA in Actuarial Science and Economics from Temple University and completed the ITT Executive Development Program at Duke University. He is a member of the American Academy of Actuaries, a fellow of the Society of Actuaries and a Chartered Life Underwriter.
