Anthony McIntyre graduated from Cinnaminson High School in 1974. He did post graduate studies at Marine Military Academy (MMA) in Harlingen, TX on scholarship in 1975 lettering in varsity football and track. After graduating from MMA he enrolled in Temple University and graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration.

After completing his military obligation Mr. McIntyre was employed by Xerox Corporation in 1982 and was a President's Club winner for five consecutive years. He served in a variety of

positions culminating in a top marketing executive in the Computer and Networking Division.

In 1987 Mr. McIntyre joined The Graham Company. He made significant contributions to the agency's success through his special expertise in a variety of insurance disciplines. He was promoted to Vice President/Principal Stock Holder and Board Member. He sold his interest in 2002.

Mr. McIntyre founded The McIntyre Group in 2002. After growing the business to the top 1% of Brokers/Agents in the United States based on revenue, The McIntyre Group merged with Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. in 2013. Gallagher McIntyre specializes in complex Property and Casualty insurance for well managed companies. The company services the risk management needs of large, complex accounts that have global operations.

Mr. McIntyre has been a Trustee of the Marine Military Academy (MMA) since 1987 and was elected as Chairman of the Board in 2005 and served as Chairman through 2012. It is interesting to note that he was the first alumni and Army Officer to be elected Chairman and he was unanimously elected by the Board. Mr. McIntyre continues to serve as an active Board Member where he has given considerable resources, leading the way with generous contributions for capital campaigns and endowment scholarships. Mr. McIntyre also serves on the Board of Valley Forge Military Academy.

Mr. McIntyre has been married to his wife, Christine, for 31 years and is blessed with two children (Jennifer and Caroline). He resides in Medford, New Jersey.
